The Kuwaiti Association for Learning Differences (KALD) is a non-profit organization that collaboratively works towards helping all individuals, especially students in private schools and special education in Kuwait, who have Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder and Learning Difficulties through setting up awareness programs, training courses, and other educational activities.

Masharee Al Khair, the charity foundation of Kuwait Projects Holding Company (KIPCO), funds KALD since 2007 by Chairwoman Mrs. Amaal Al Sayer and a volunteer group of educators, parents and specialists in the field of Learning Difficulties.

The Association was founded in 2007 to support and assist students with specific Learning Difficulties, a term used for people with

an average or above average IQ, but with difficulties in learning and, sometimes, social skills.

KALD supports this group of students for several reasons: first, because their numbers are large. According to international statistics, 4% -10% of students have these difficulties.

Second, they are a national and global wealth, where the intelligence rate of a large number of them puts them in the category of distinguished and geniuses who can enrich the world with their ideas, inventions and achievements if they are cared for since childhood.

Therefore, the first logo of the association represents the colors of the Kuwaiti flag to confirm the identity of the association and confirm that the place of its launch is home.

After working in this field for several years it became clear that what is known as attention deficit disorder and ADHD has not been given enough attention and that no one in Kuwait is concerned with students with this disorder, despite the large number and its negative impact on their academic, psychological and social life.

The association then decided to reflect the new society's slogan of the society's work and philosophy so that it focuses on ADHD without giving up learning difficulties. Of every

10 children with ADHD, 2 have learning difficulties, especially reading and writing. Hence, the letter A in the middle is orange, the global color of this disorder, as a symbol. Learning difficulties will remain an important focus of KALD's work and are symbolized by the LD (learning difficulties) of the association's name.

The way in which they are expressed may vary over an individual's lifetime, depending on the interaction between the demands of the environment and the individual's strengths and needs.

Learning Difficulties

Learning disabilities are neurological-based disorders that affect the aquiring, retaining, understanding, organizing or using verbal and/or non-verbal information.

Learning disabilities range in severity and continually interfere with the acquisition and use of one or more of the following important skills:

- Oral Language:(e.g. listening, speaking, understanding)
- Reading:(e.g. decoding, comprehension)
- Writing: (e.g. spelling, written expression)
- 4 Mathematics:
 (e.g. computation, problem solving)
- Memory:
 (e.g. working, long and short term memory)
- 6 LD can also interfere with higher level skills such as organization, time planning, abstract reasoning, long and short term memory and attention.

Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder

ADHD is a medical neurobiological disorder that affects children and teens and can continue into adulthood. Symptoms of ADHD can vary from day to day. There are three types of ADHD and each is defined according to which symptoms stand out the most:


- Predominantly Inattentive Type
- Predominantly Hyperactive Impulsive Type
- 3 Combined Type (inattentive + hyperactive + impulsive)

These behaviors can affect the students' academic achievement at school and strain their relationships with others.

Did you know that there are positive aspects to ADHD?



People with ADHD characteristics are more likely to reach higher levels of creative thought and achievement than people without these characteristics.



According to international statistics, the percentage of students with learning difficulties ranges from 10% to 4% of the number of students. If we take the middle percentage (6%) and apply it to the number of students in Kuwait (600 thousand students), the number of students who are likely to have learning difficulties is 36000 students.

Many students with LD and ADHD have difficulties with executive function (EF)

Executive functions are a set of processes needed to manage oneself and resources in order to achieve a goal. Students with EF deficit exhibit difficulties in mastering skills, such as planning and organization.

LD and ADHD have a negative impact on the student's life:

Psychological problems that could be sever, such as depression as a result of the discrepancy between the student's intelligence and his low academic achievement.

Behavioral problems that affect the students' relationship with their peers, teachers and family. Putting pressure on the parents' relationship with each other, leading often to divorce.

Dropping out of school, causing accidents that could be deadly, addiction and unlawful actions.

With the right help, students with LD and ADHD can and do learn successfully.

Through a combination of psychological, behavioral and medical treatments, special education services and the full cooperation between family and school, there are no limits to what can be achieved.



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Chair **Note**

When I reflect on how and why I founded the Kuwait Association for Learning Differences (KALD), I see the passage of 15 years as a journey that started in a narrow school yard and led to a wide expanse. It started with a limited term: «learning difficulties» and led to a comprehensive term: «learning differences».

The journey started when my son was diagnosed with attention deficit hyperactivity

disorder (ADHD) and difficulties. learning joined the parents and teachers' association (PTA) of his school to raise the awareness of parents of students with learning difficulties about these learning difficulties, with the limited information I had at the time about the nature of these difficulties and how to address them. I also wanted to defend the rights of these students to an appropriate school environment where they may succeed and build a promising future, and to emphasize the importance supporting school administrations to exert their best efforts in teaching our children.

By reading articles, scientific global research, and statistics on this subject, I discovered the enormous number of students who have these difficulties and the negative effects of these difficulties on their academic, psychological and social life. It became necessary to deepen and expand the scope of my work in order to

benefit the largest possible number of students in all Kuwait's private schools.

his infinite God. in magnanimity, surrounded me with people who love philanthropy and with scholars and specialists who volunteered to help me draw a vision for an organization that would work at the national level in Kuwait, and they honored me by forming its first board of directors.

In 2007, thanks to the generosity of His Highness Sheikh Hamad Sabah Al-Ahmad Al-Sabah, through Masharee Al Khair Charity Foundation of the Kuwait Projects Company (KIPCO), the Kuwaiti Society for Learning Differences (KALD) was formed.

The flow of the river of goodness did not stop there. The Center for Child Assessment and Education hosted us at their headquarters to start our work and they were generous with their experience in this field, which they earned during twenty years in the field of learning difficulties.

After years of work, God blessed us with a gift given to us by Mr. Faisal Hamad Al Ayyar. This was new headquarters built at his own expense, which enabled us to expand the scope of our work to defend the rights of our children throughout our nation.

After ten years of work it became clear that the choice of the term «learning differences» in the name of the association instead of the term «learning difficulties» was a wise choice. It reflected most of what we aspire is to provide: an environment at the community, school, professional levels that accepts, cherishes, and celebrates differences individuals between because this is a source of diversity that enriches human civilization.




